

RIDE THE PRIVATE RAIL CAR – BERLIN

“\$100 Bucks” PITTSBURGH RAILFAN SPECIAL - May 26-27, 2017

Looking for something to do over the Memorial Day weekend? A hundred bucks can get you a day on a private railroad car!

Occasionally, we offer discounted rides when we position the BERLIN to/from other cities in preparation for a charter or scheduled trip departing from outside of Pittsburgh. Some positioning moves are no-frills; just a great ride and adventure on a private rail car. Join us for a trip designed especially for railfans as we travel from Huntington WV to New York NY and onward to Pittsburgh PA! Ride aboard the private, Pullman, 1956 built former American Orient Express executive sleeper BERLIN through the scenic New River Gorge in “Wild and Wonderful West (By Gawd) Virginia”, and on the Northeast Corridor Cardinal and Pennsylvanian routes. This is a trip only for real railfans – to keep this trip to the lowest price possible there will be no crew aboard other than the car owner. We will stock standard self-serve railfan snacks aboard the BERLIN, but meals will be on a YO-YO basis (**Y**ou’re **O**n **Y**our **O**wn), or in the Amtrak cafe. All room suites will be held open as “Lounge” space, and the car will be running backwards on May 26 between Huntington WV and NYC, as well as May 27 on the Pennsylvanian from Philadelphia to Pittsburgh (over the Rockville Bridge and Horseshoe Curve) - so that the vestibule becomes our rear platform! If you want to learn anything about private car operation, this is a special behind the scenes, learn how to run a railcar trip! If you desire, you can even take a turn as the car’s Pullman Conductor or Porter during the trip.

NOTE: The BERLIN will also be hosting a separate ONE DAY round trip from Pittsburgh to Harrisburg and return on Sunday May 28, 2017. This is a FULL SERVICE day trip including the service of an on board steward providing light breakfast snacks, specially prepared box lunches and dinner on board. Snacks, water, coffee and a choice of beer and wine will be available. The fare for this one day round trip is \$200 per person (see fare listing below for partial trip segments).

SCHEDULE

May 26, 2017 (Friday) - Depart Huntington WV at 7:16am, arrive in New York Penn Station at 9:56 pm, detrain to a NYC hotel of your choice (not included in the fare).

May 27, 2017 (Saturday) - Arrive at New York Penn Station approximately one hour prior to scheduled departure, depart New York Penn Station on Train #43 the Pennsylvanian at 10:52am, arrive in Harrisburg at 2:26pm, depart Harrisburg at 2:36pm, arrive in Altoona at 5:06pm, arrive in Pittsburgh at 8:05pm.

May 28, 2017 (Sunday) – Arrive at Pittsburgh Amtrak Station approximately one hour prior to scheduled departure time on Train #42 the Pennsylvanian at 7:30am, arrive in Altoona at 10:01am, arrive in Harrisburg at 12:55pm, depart Harrisburg at 2:36pm, arrive Altoona at 5:06pm, arrive Pittsburgh at 8:05pm.

NOTE: This trip can be enjoyed in several different ways and with several different price points: Amtrak, Hotel and Museum fares are not included.

1. Ride Amtrak's Pennsylvanian Saturday May 27 from Pittsburgh to Altoona, spend the day at the Railroader's Memorial Museum and return to Pittsburgh on the BERLIN.
2. Ride Amtrak's Pennsylvanian Saturday May 27 from Pittsburgh to Harrisburg, spend an hour around the station and return to Pittsburgh on the BERLIN.
3. Ride Amtrak's Pennsylvanian Friday May 26 from Pittsburgh to New York City, enjoy an evening in New York City (perhaps dinner & a show), hotel in New York City and return to Pittsburgh on the BERLIN Saturday May 27.
4. Take the Amtrak Capitol Limited Friday May 26 from Pittsburgh to Washington DC, spend a few hours in DC before transferring to the BERLIN for some high speed travel on the Northeast Corridor from Washington to New York City May 26, hotel in New York City, and return to Pittsburgh on the BERLIN May 27.
5. Travel on the BERLIN from either Harrisburg or Altoona to Pittsburgh May 27, and return on May 28.
